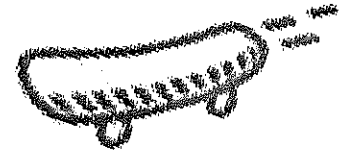
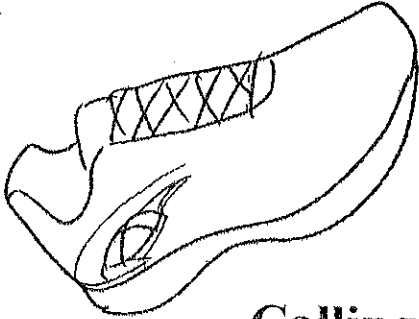

VBS News

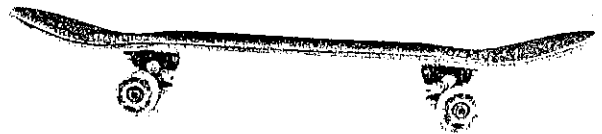
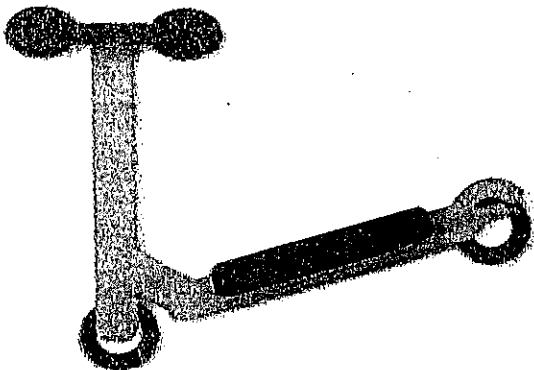
